AN HISTORIC PRESERVATION AND DEVELOPMENT WALKING TOUR

You are invited to participate in an historic preservation and development walking tour through Newark, NJ. Beginning at the apartments at the Hahne & Co. building, participants will visit sites including Hahne & Co., Military Park, Harriet Tubman Square, 15 Washington Place, Walker House and more. Join us to see how many of the city's landmarks have been repurposed for modern commercial, educational, and recreational use.

TOUR PLAN AND LOGISTICS:

Tour will start promptly at 1:00 p.m. Participants will meet at the Hahne & Co. Grand Court Auditorium, 625 Mayor Kenneth A. Gibson Blvd., Newark and will last about 2 hours, ending at approximately 3:00 p.m. The tour will examine how an older central city preserves and adaptively reuses its stock.

Participants must provide their own transportation. The Hahne & Co. building is less than a mile walk from the Newark New Jersey Transit Station. Or from Newark's Penn Station, take the Newark Light Rail to the Military Park Station, and head toward Broad Street, then turn left onto Broad Street/Kenneth A. Gibson Blvd.

The tour is being led by Bloustein alumnus **Emily Manz MCRP '13**, co-founder of Have You Met Newark Tours and Chief Business Development Officer and Director of Marketing, Invest Newark and Bloustein School Professor **David Listokin**.
